

CARE OF YOUR NEW DOORS

By observing the following simple rules your doors will retain their 'as new' appearance and give many years of trouble free service

- 1) Pre finished doors should be regularly 'wiped down' with a damp (not wet) cloth, removing any deposits from crevices etc.
- 2) Ensure that no doors are subjected to continuous exposure to spilled water. If the doors accidentally become wet immediately remove the water from the surface of the doors with a dry cloth.
- 3) Care should be exercised with the positioning of portable appliances, such as toasters, kettles etc. If these are placed directly below wall cabinets, then over a period of time the heat and moisture may cause some deterioration in your doors.
- 4) Do not permit hard objects to impact the door surface as this may break the resistant finish and allow the core material to become exposed to moisture etc causing deterioration.
- 5) Pets and/or small children should be prevented from scratching the surface as this may also result in deterioration.
- 6) In general, wherever possible, avoid situations which allow continuous exposure of your doors to direct heat or moisture.
